

Speaker FAQs – CES 2024:

- **Where do I pick up my badge?** All show attendees, including media and individual exhibitor personnel must pick up their own CES 2024 official badge at a remote badge pickup location. You cannot pick up badges for other attendees.

To pick up your badge at a remote badge pick up location, you must present the following:

- Government-issued photo ID
- Registration confirmation – either saved in your Google or Apple wallet or confirmation email with QR code to scan.

- **What time should I arrive?** We recommend you arrive at the Speaker Lounge in your venue an hour before your panel is scheduled to begin. Head over to the tech table in your session room 15 mins ahead of the start time to get set up

- **Can I access all Speaker Lounges even if I am not speaking that day?** Yes, Speaker Lounge access across all show venues is a benefit of speaking.
- **What is included in the Speaker Lounge?** You can meet in one of our designated Speaker Lounges throughout the show to pick up your speaker ribbon, gift, meet your fellow speakers, enjoy complimentary Wi-Fi, speak with CES staff, relax and grab a refreshment.
- **Should I create a PowerPoint Presentation?** Although PPTs are not required, we do allow them at the discretion of your moderator. If you decide to use one, please follow these instructions:
 - Use the official CES PPT template. If you need a copy of this, please reach out to speakersupport@cta.tech.
 - Please bring your presentation on a flash drive —or a personal laptop—with you onsite. Once you have arrived at your session room, please bring your presentation to the AV table for setup.
 - Please do not plan any presentations that are dependent on WiFi.
 - Laptops compatible with PowerPoint will be in the room. Our projectors are compatible with VGA, DVI and HDMI connections.
- **Can I have a colleague record or take pictures of my session?** Yes, as long as they are seated in a chair and using a hand-held device such as a small camera or tablet. Unfortunately, we cannot allow anyone to stand in the aisles or set up a tripod in the room.

- **Can my colleagues attend my session?** If you are speaking on a track that is paid, you will receive 3 complimentary guest tickets upon check-in at the Speaker Lounge. Your colleagues can show this complimentary guest ticket, along with their CES badge, to the room monitors standing at the door of your session.
- **Will hotel and travel be provided?** No. Speakers are responsible for booking their own travel and housing. You can check our website for more information on booking [hotels](#) and other travel tips.
- **What do I get with the Deluxe Conference Pass?** All CES speakers receive a complimentary Deluxe Conference Pass. This will give you access to all show floors, and all conference sessions at CES.
